Anti Doping

Doping is forbidden: "Think positive – test negative". All competitors shall follow the IOF Anti-Doping Code.



Clothing

There are no regulations regarding clothing.

Embargoed Areas

All competition areas have been embargoed.

Accommodation

All athletes will have a centralized accommodation.

Transportation

Coaches will be arranged for athletes from the Accommodation to the Event Venue and from the Event Venue back to the Accommodation.

Please note that no personal rental car is advised as no parking will be provided at the Accommodation nor the Arena.

Accreditation

Passports for all athletes shall be produced upon accreditation. The organiser reserves the right to prohibit athletes from competing until the required passports are properly inspected.

Training Opportunity

The AsTOC will be held in Nov 2019. A separate bulletin is available.

Climate

Hong Kong's climate is sub-tropical, tending towards temperate for nearly half the year. During November and December, there are pleasant breezes and sunshine. Temperature usually ranges between 16-20 °C, whilst occasionally temperature may drop below 10 °C. the probability of rainfall is moderate.
