- The top 15 in the World Ranking list (as it stands 3 months prior to the first race of the event) with a maximum of the best 2 from each Federation for the PreO O class and TempO.

All competitors must be full passport-holding citizens of the country they are representing.

Competitors representing member Federations of the IOF can compete in the Championships.

In the Relay competitions, each country can only have one team in each class.

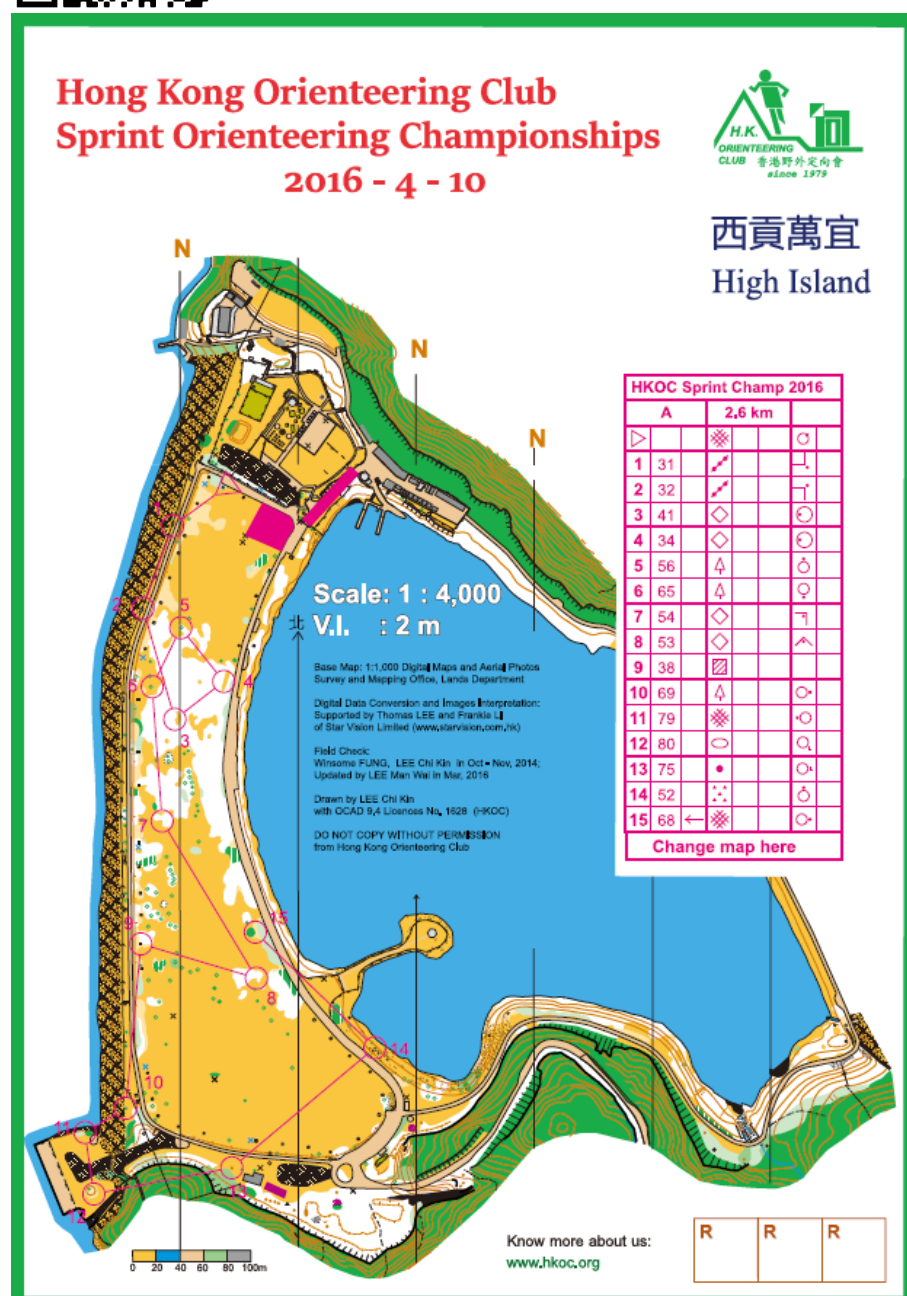
MAPS, COURSES AND TERRAINS

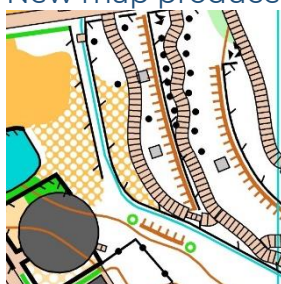

Scale: 1:4,000 / Contour Interval 2m

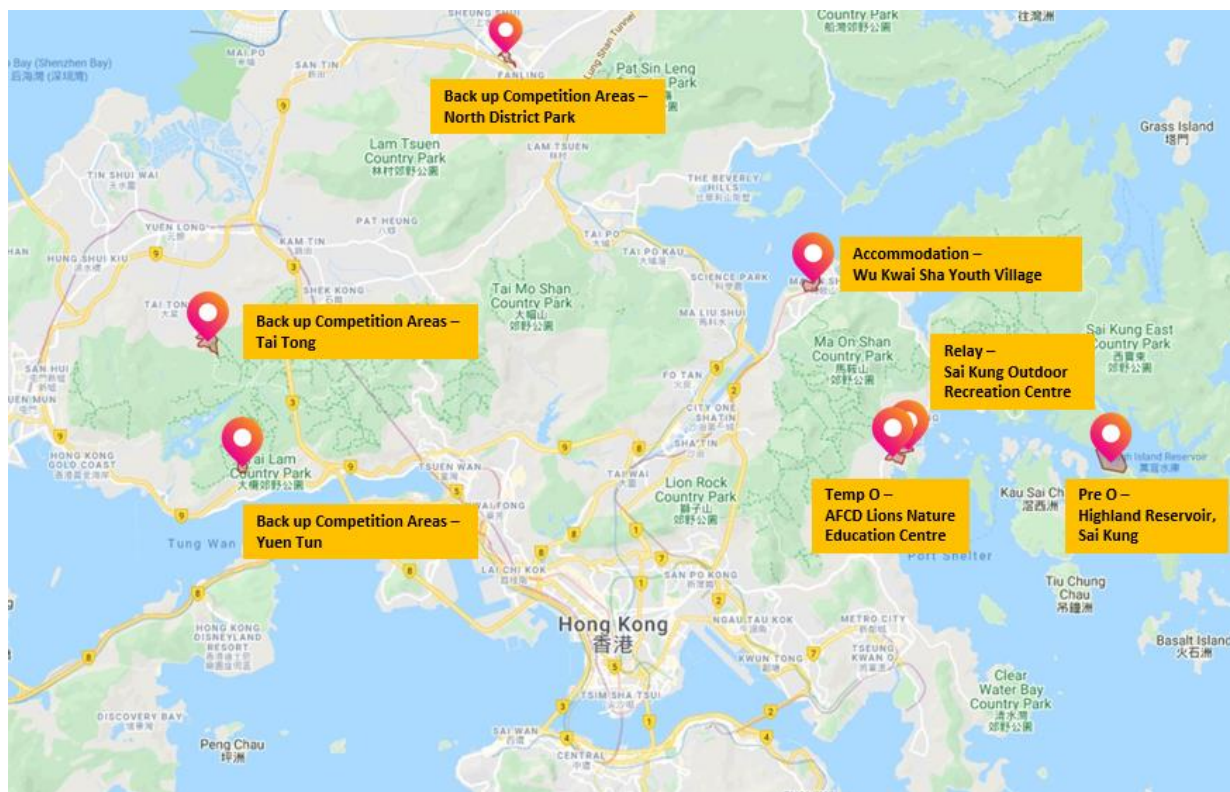

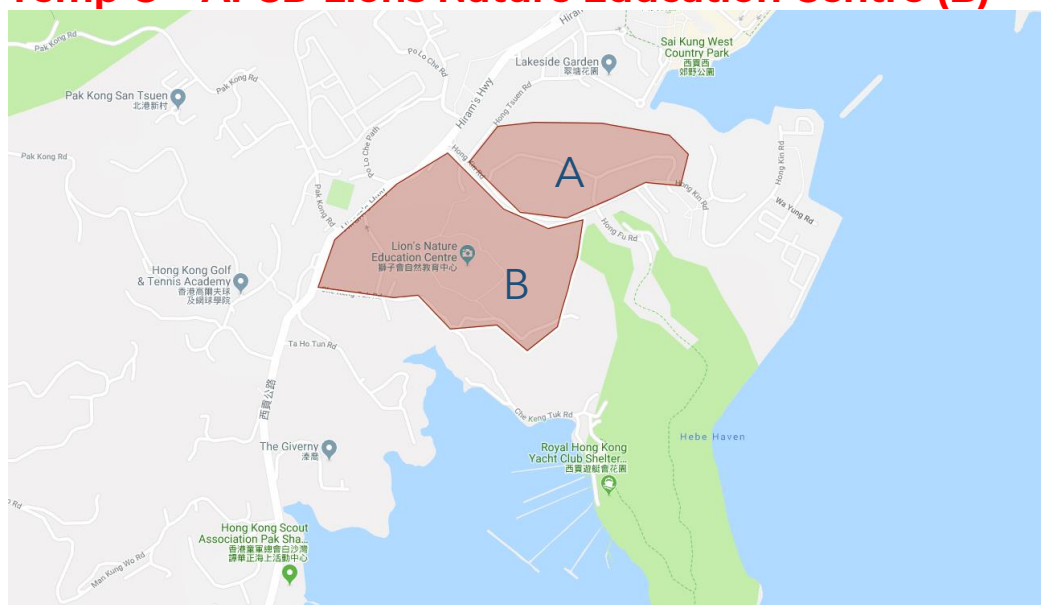

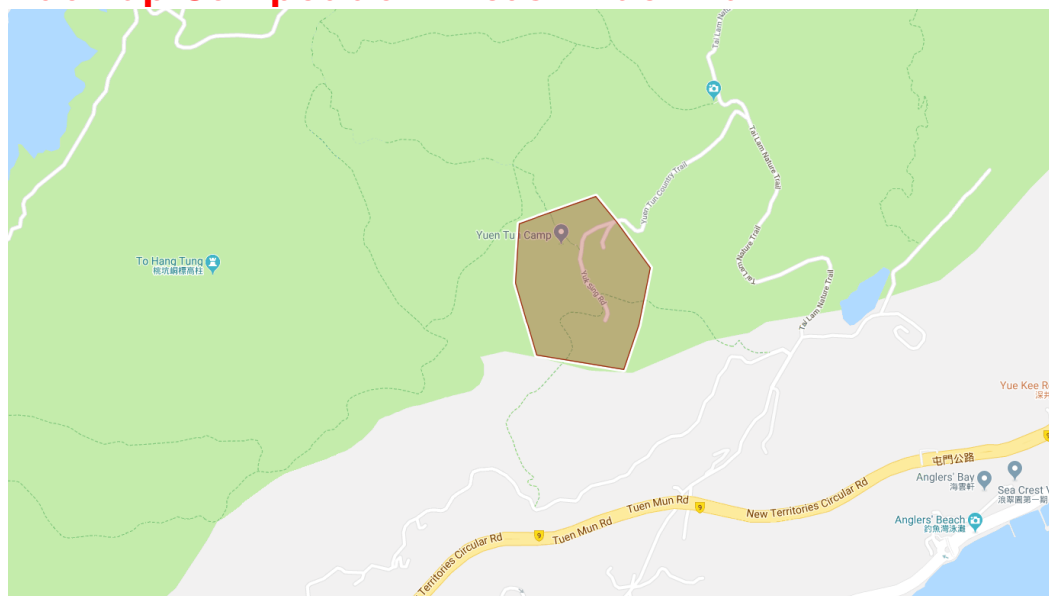
Pre O – Highland Reservoir, Sai Kung



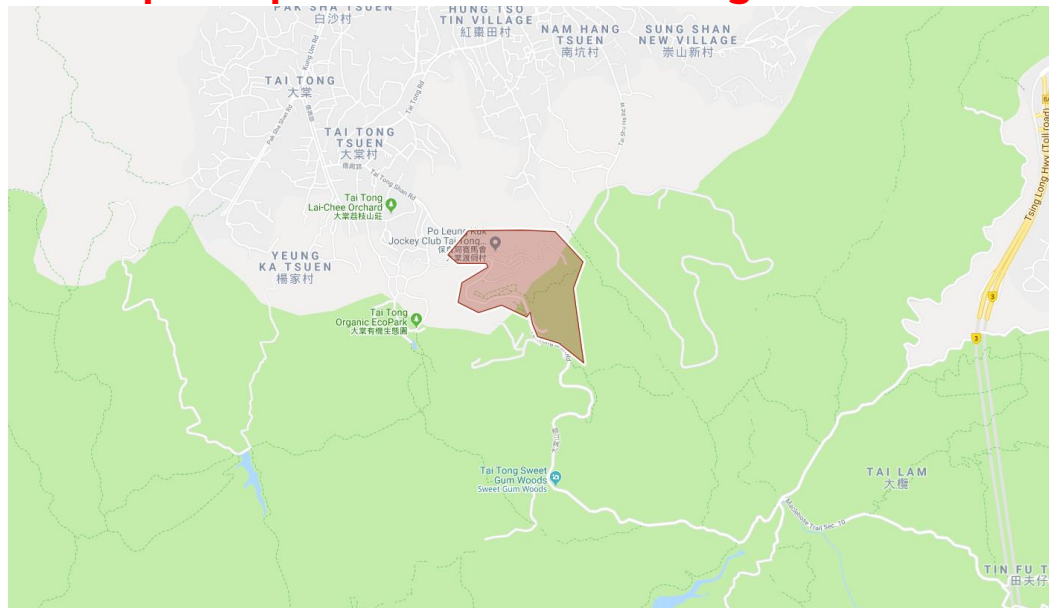
Relay – Sai Kung Outdoor Recreation Centre (A) & Temp O – AFCD Lions Nature Education Centre (B)



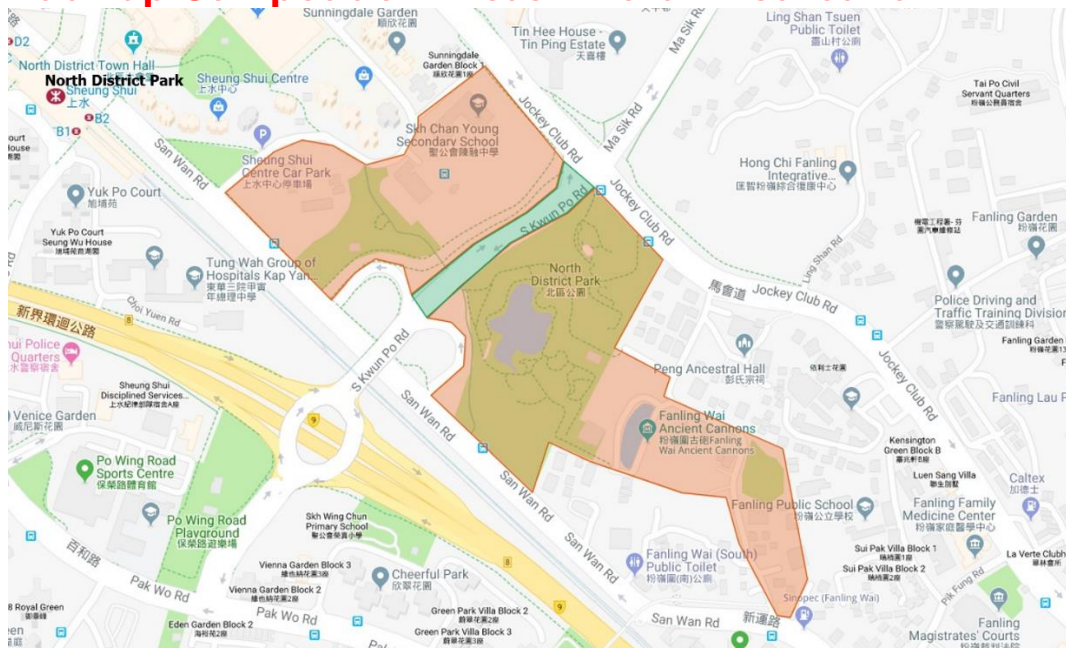
Back up Competition Areas – Yuen Tun

ANTI DOPING

Doping is forbidden: "Think positive – test negative". All competitors shall follow the IOF Anti-Doping Code.

CLOTHING

Please refer to the Competition Rules for Trail Orienteering.

Competitors should wear the national team clothing of their Federation during competitions for identification.

There is no special recommended footwear. There may be some mosquitoes in competition terrains.

ACCOMMODATION



All athletes and officials will reside in the official accommodation (4 Person Dormitory or 6 Person Dormitory) at Wu Kwai Sha Youth Village with breakfast and dinner included. Please let us know any Special Food Requirement is needed. Several rooms are suitable for wheelchair users.

Lunch is not included in the package and you can buy your food at the supermarket and convenient stores nearby for lunch packs. Also, you can dine out as there are many restaurants near the accommodation with different choice of food. However, room services will not be provided.



TRANSPORTATION

There will be one booking per federation basis of official transport provided by organiser, this transportation booking will be either a round trip between the airport and the village before and after the competition or a one-way trip to the village from the airport before the competition.

Official transport to/from all arena from Youth Village and return shall be provided. All Competitors of Open and Physically Challenged, Team Officials and Accompanying persons must use the official transport.

Please note that no personal rental car is advised as no parking will be provided at the Accommodation nor the Arena.

Registration for Teams

All WTOC 2020 accreditation and entries must be made in IOF Eventor. The entry form will be available in mid-July.

Deadlines for Federations

- The deadline for Team Size Entry is 28 September 2020
- The deadline Payment is 16 October 2020
- The deadline for Team Name (Names of the competitors) Entry is 18 November 2020

Passports and a valid IOF Athlete Licence for all athletes shall be produced upon accreditation. The organiser reserves the right to prohibit athletes from competing until the required passports are properly inspected.
